In 2009, 250 children were given advocates, averaging \$600 for each child. Black Tie Bowling helps CASA to close the gap of the almost 200 children who still need an advocate. Black Tie Bowling also allows Canyon Concert Dance Center to continue to provide an average of 20 scholarships to low income students each year.
